Items held by Sherborne Museum

Ken House, John House and Barbara Elsmore



A review of all the items concerning the history of Foster's School donated to and subsequently held by Sherborne Museum began in May 2012 and was undertaken by Ken House, John House and Barbara Elsmore.

This review was completed in December 2015 and the archive was found to contain over 540 items spanning the years 1874-2013. Around 100 photographs were located including 44 whole school photos and many sporting photos.

In December 2015 additional items, held by Ken House President of the Old Fosters' Association, were submitted to the Museum for their consideration for accession to the school archive.

[In June 2020 Sherborne Museum accessioned 28 additional items donated by Ken House which were agreed and signed for by the Chairman of the OFA. This brings the total number of items to c570. These additional items are listed in blue.](#)

In time the Museum will be producing a list of all items held by them and sending a copy to the OFA for the website.
